
Movement Cards

Bridge Gem can print Movement Cards for any of the Movements that it supports.

Movement Cards are produced 9 to a page in a 3 x 3 matrix. The page can be printed or saved as as an **Html** file which can subsequently be read and printed by any web-browser (eg Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Firefox etc).


To access the Movement Card facility, start an Event and select the Movement. See the user guide, Running an Event, for how to do this.

After selecting the Movement click on the View/Edit button.



The **View Movement** form is displayed.

Click on the **Movement Cards** item in its menu bar. A new window is displayed with the Movement Cards for the Movement displayed in a 3 x 3 matrix.



If your computer has a printer installed, click the **Print** button to print directly to the printer.

If your computer does not have a printer installed, click the **Save** button to save the Movement Cards as an **.html** file. The Windows' standard **Save File Dialogbox** is displayed which allows you to save the **.html** file anywhere you want.

The .html file can subsequently be emailed, copied etc to a computer that has a printer, and printed by opening the file in a web-browser, eg Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge or Firefox, and printing from the browser.
